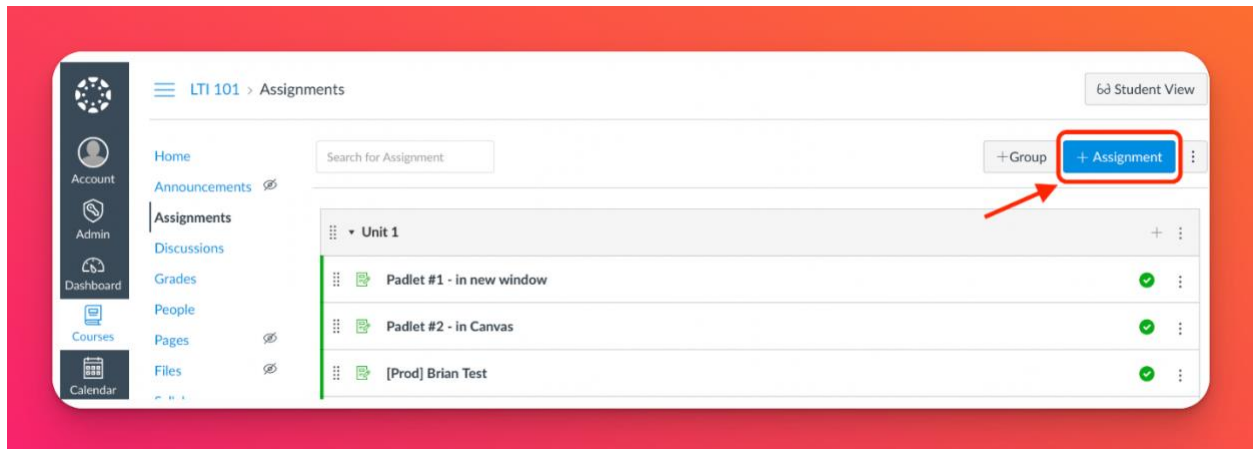


Add Padlet to Canvas Assignments (*Teachers*)

Before proceeding, please ensure that your Canvas admin has allowed access for Padlet in the above instructions!

1. Create a new Assignment

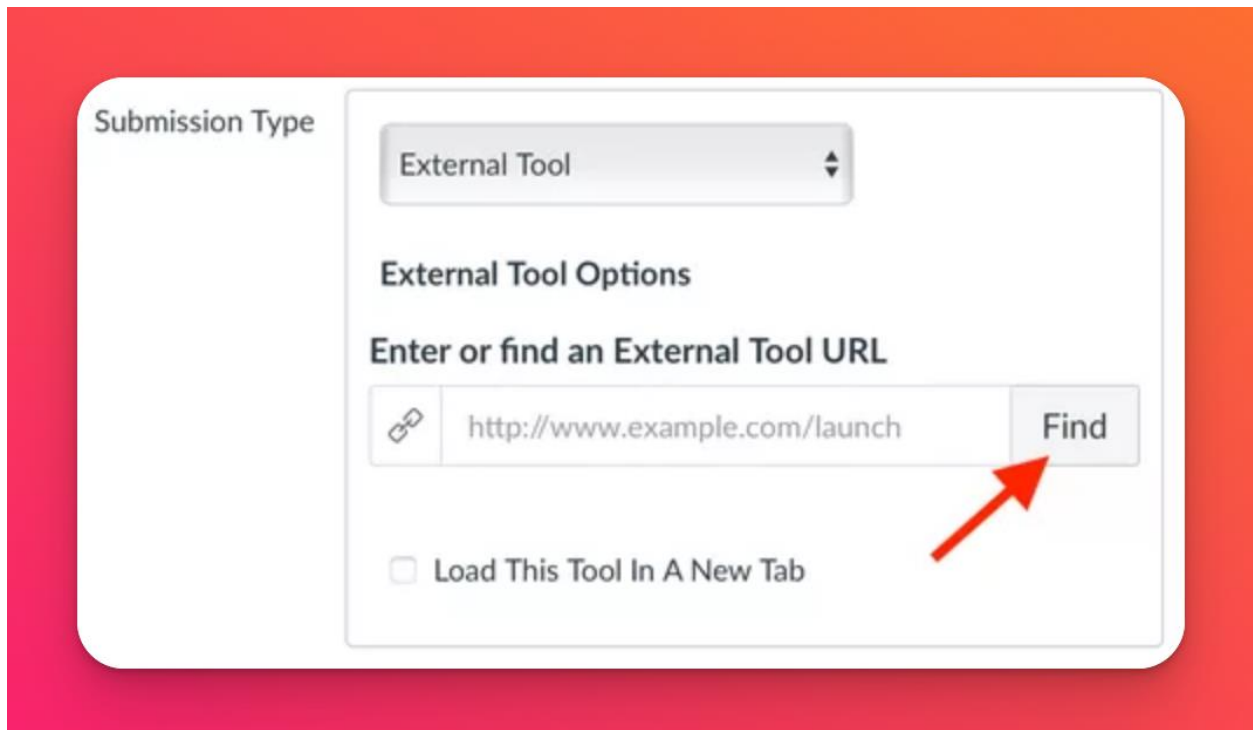
Courses > Assignments > + Assignment



2. Add External Tool

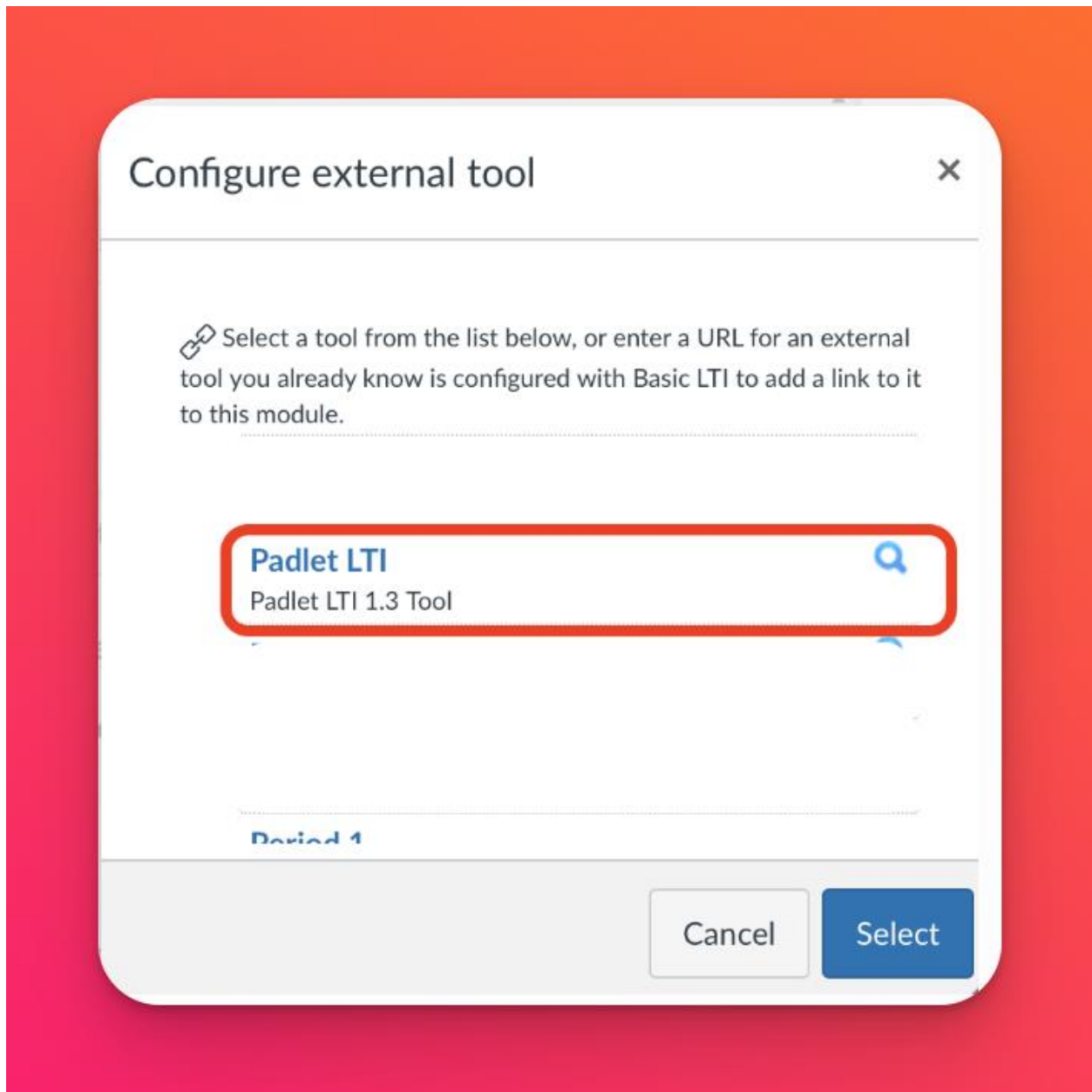
Head to **Submission Type**, indicate **External Tool** and click on **Find**.

Note: Do *not* add a padlet link to the field.



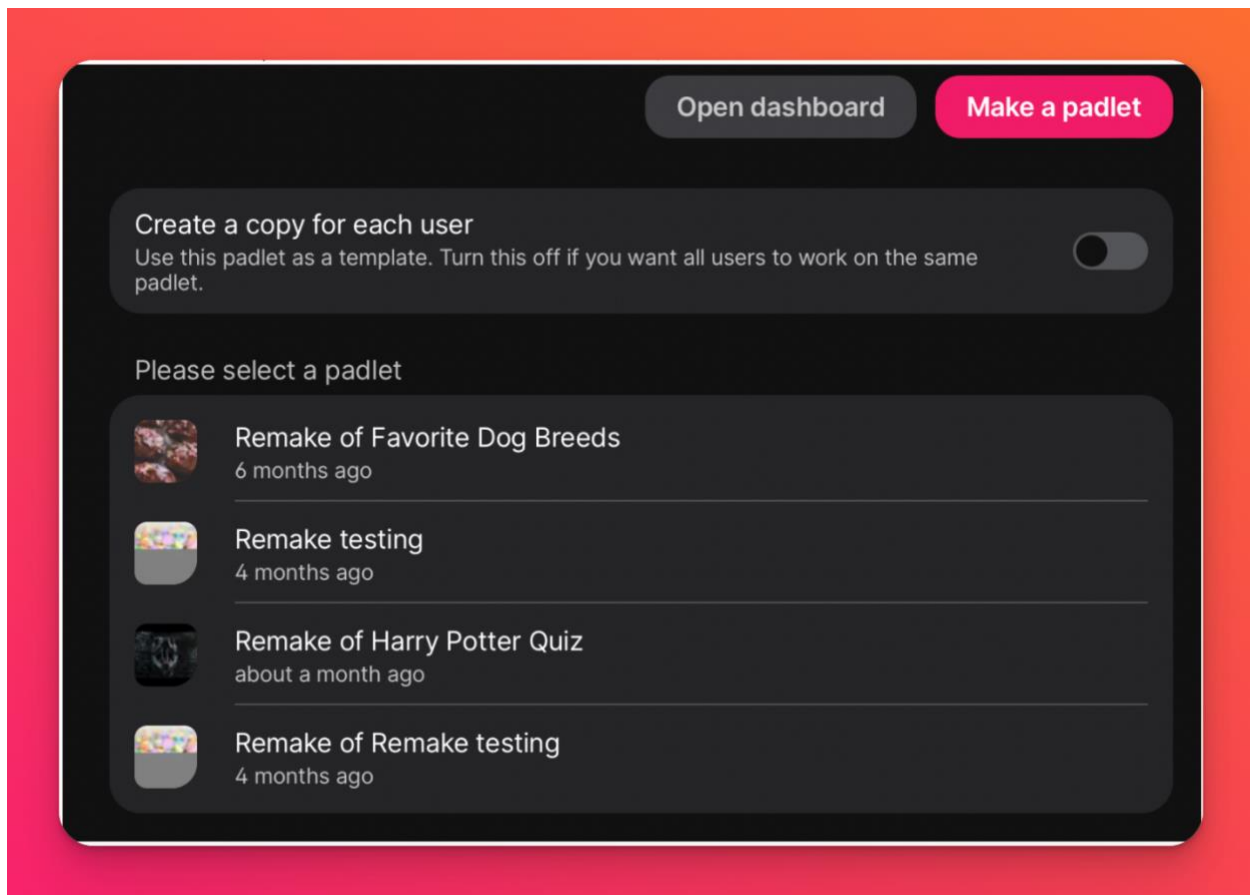
3. Add Padlet as an external tool

Depending on what the Admin named it, find **Padlet** on the list of tools and click on it.

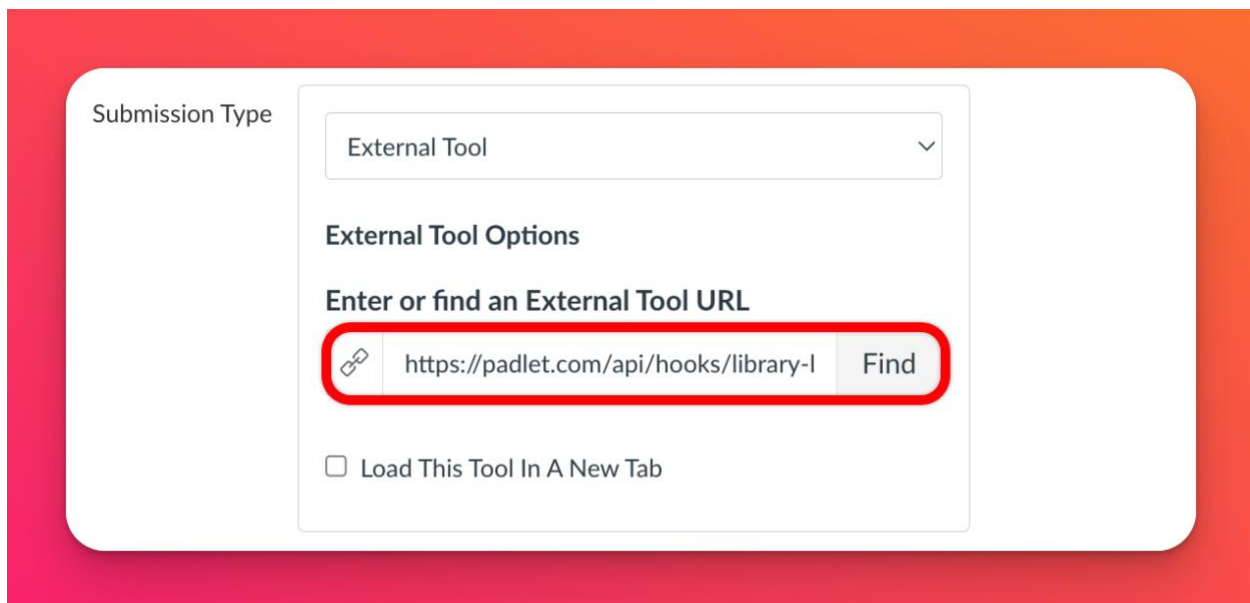


4. Log into Padlet and select a padlet.

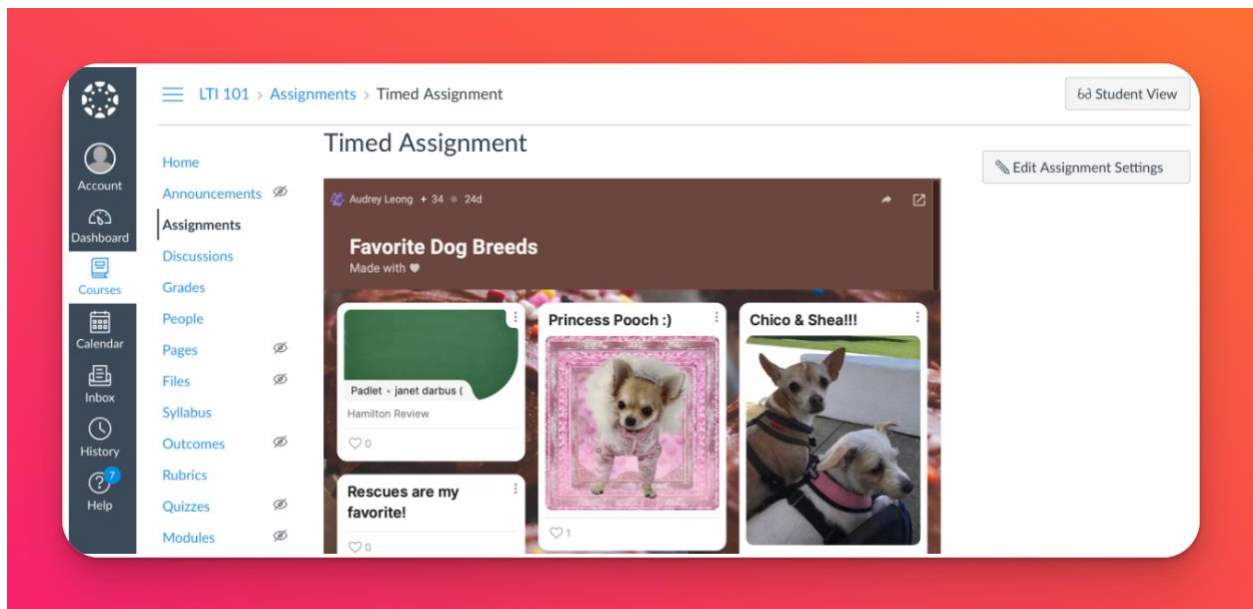
You will then be prompted to log into your Padlet for Schools account on Padlet. After logging in, you get to select which padlet you want to add to the assignment. Once this is done, click on **Select**.



A link should show up in this field. **Save and Publish** or **Save this Assignment**.



The padlet should show up like this on Canvas!



Additional sharing options

If you want students to work on their own copy of the padlet, toggle the '*Create a copy for each user*' to the **ON** position. Students will get their own copy when they click on the link in the assignment, and you will be automatically added as a shared member to the padlet.

Note that turning **ON** the '*Copy*' option will prevent you from seeing all student posts in a single padlet.
